City Manager, Michael Harris gave an overview of the Ordinance to Collect Hotel Motel Tax and explained why this ordinance was before Council once again.



Council Member Adoma made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:05pm with Council Member Clanton providing the second. **The motion carried unanimously.**


