The City Council of the City of Stonecrest does hereby announce that the millage rate will be set at a special called meeting to be held virtually and broadcasted live on the City's YouTube Channel immediately following the final public hearing on June 24, 2020 at 6:00 p.m. and pursuant to the requirements of O.C.G.A. Section 48-5-32 does hereby publish the following presentation of the current year's tax digest and levy, along with the history of the tax digest and levy for the past five years.

Note that this is the first year the City of Stonecrest has imposed a City millage rate. The Net Taxes % Increase reflects an increase of 100% because this is the first year of adoption. However, this City millage rate is exactly equal to the rate levied by DeKalb County in 2019 for Special Services provided (except Police) that will be eliminated by DeKalb County for the City of Stonecrest effective with tax year 2020. The Net Taxes % Increase therefore is actually zero (\$0).
